ISLE OF WIGHT BREWERIES

Goddards Brewery – Ryde

- Ale of Wight 3.7% - A refreshing, bright blonde ale, with delicate citrus notes.
- Fuggle Dee Dum 4.8% - Brewed with roasted malts and English Fuggle hops, to give a smoky, spicy hoppiness on the nose.

Island Brewery – Shalfleet

- Earl's RDA 5.0% - A rich dark Ale (RDA), made with Crystal and chocolate malts together with roasted barley.
- Wight Gold 4.0% - A well liked golden brown beer with rounded malt and hops throughout.

Special Anniversary Brews – 50 Year Events

- 15 Guinea Special 4.5% - A pale beer with Chocolate Rye malt complimented by Challenger and Golding hops ending in a dryish finish.
- Jeff's Driving Test Ale 4.5% - A rich roast stout full of barley and oats, gently hopped with Crystal malt notes.
- First IOW Pop Festival 4.5% - A German- style cloudy, wheat beer with German wheat yeast giving a marzipan type taste.

Yates' Brewery – Newchurch

- Holy Joe 4.9% - An amber coloured ale with a bittersweet aftertaste, ground coriander is added to the brew to give it an extra citrusy, spicy finish.
- Islander 4.0% - A very easy drinking Isle of Wight amber coloured ale, brewed with Goldings and Chinook hops to give a full bodied taste.

MAINLAND BREWERIES

Bath Ales – Warmley, Bristol

- Summer's Hare 4.3% - A beer with a full malt flavour and a fabulously fruity bitterness.

Beartown Brewery – Congleton, Cheshire

- Bearly Literate 4.5% - A golden pale ale packed with the flavours of summer fruits and floral scents, ending in a smooth dryness.

Bude Brewery – Bude, Cornwall

- Haven 4.2% - An amber ale which has hints of coffee and citrus and packs a hoppy kick after the addition of Chinook hops.

Butcombe Brewery – Wrington, Somerset

- Adam Henson's Rare Breed 3.8% - A distinctive, clean tasting pale ale with a smooth citrus twist using Maris Otter barley and aromatic Fuggle hops, plus fruity Cascade and Amarillo hops together with pure Mendip spring water.

Cameron's Brewery – Hartlepool, Co. Durham

- M & M 4.3% - A Mango and Mandarin infused pale ale giving a sweet and juicy, full of fruit, flavour.

Castle Rock Brewery – Nottingham

- Screech Owl 5.5% - This is a particular favourite of the Railway's General Manager and is a classic IPA with an immensely hoppy aroma and bitter taste, but with a balanced sweetness.

Cerne Abbas Brewery – Cerne Abbas, Dorset

- Pompey Pals 3.8% - A Limited Edition pale ale commemorating the Great War 'Pals' Battalion from Portsmouth, and is a hand crafted light straw coloured ale with a pleasant fruity taste and not too hoppy.
- Gurt Coconuts Rum Stout 6.7% - It's Gurt, it's Rum, and it's Coconutty. Brewed in an old oak rum cask and with no black sticky explosions!

Charnwood Brewery – Loughborough, Leicestershire

- Vixen 4% - A well-balanced, copper coloured, best bitter with subtle hints of honey, spice and hedgerow fruits all together with a fruity nose and finish.

Dark Star Brewery – Partridge Green, West Sussex

- Partridge Best Bitter 4.0% - A traditional Sussex best bitter using Maris Otter, Crystal and Chocolate malts with East Kent Golding hops.

Fuzzy Duck – Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire

- Cunning Stunt 4.3% - An amber coloured beer with a blackcurrant and herbal aroma.

Green Duck Brewery – Stourbridge, West Midlands

- Hysteria 4.5% - A zesty, golden, American pale ale where citrus blasts of lemon and limes from Cashmere hops pair up with Idaho 7's refreshing tropical fruit flavour burst.

Hop Back Brewery – Downton, Wiltshire

- Summer Lightning 5.0% - The previous Bar Manager's favourite and is a golden strong bitter with a hoppy aroma and slight astringent bitterness, balance with some fruit sweetness in the dry aftertaste.

Kelham Island Brewery – Sheffield, South Yorkshire

- Shooting Stars 4.2% - An all English pale ale brewed with locally sourced malt and three English hops giving this beer a fruity, spicy and slightly grapefruit flavour.

Lincolnshire Brewing Company – Langworth, Lincolnshire

- 1215 Magna Carta Ale 4.3% - An amber ale with a malty nose and toffee biscuit flavours, bursting with fruity aftertaste and gentle bitterness in the throat.

Magpie Brewery – Nottingham

- Trailhound 6.4% - A beer packed with flavour and complex malt gives it a light spiced, sweet caramel flavour, balanced with tons of juicy hops.

Mourne Mountains Brewery – Warrenpoint, Co. Down, N.I.

- Mild 3.7% - Unfortunately, I can't find any information on this beer!

Navigation Brewery – Nottingham

- Sour Diesel IPA 4.4% - The bitter tasting grapefruit has been added to Citra hops to produce a pale, zesty ale to be enjoyed as summer winds down.

Palmers Brewery, Bridport, Dorset

- Copper Ale 3.8% - A beautifully balanced, copper-coloured light bitter with a hoppy aroma.
- Tally Ho! 5.5% - Bar Manager, Jeff, says "YUM". However it is a complex dark-coloured Old Ale.

Rudgate Brewery – Tockwith, York

- Ruby Mild 4.4% - A nutty, rich, ruby-coloured ale, stronger than usual for a mild.

Settle Brewery – Settle, North Yorkshire

- Earl Grey IPA 4.4% - Pale in colour, the Bergamot from the Earl Grey enhances the citrus flavours in this all American hopped IPA.

Titanic Brewery – Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire

- Cappuccino Stout 4.5% - This fabulous beer combines the original dry Titanic stout with the smooth flavours of Cappuccino giving aromas of coffee and molasses and a taste of roasted coffee and chocolate.

Totally Brewed – Nottingham

- Crazy Like A Fox 4.5% - A copper-coloured, malty best bitter with a caramel aroma and a gentle bitter finish.

The Wild Beer Co – Evercreech, Somerset

- Millionaire Milk Stout 4.7% - Lactose, caramel and high quality Valrhona cocoa nibs provide a backbone alongside the roasty malts, whilst the Cornish sea salts give a savoury kick raising this beer above the norm.

Woodfordes Brewery – Woodbastwick, Norfolk

- Wherry 3.8% - This rich amber ale enjoys floods of flavours as sweet malts clash with grapefruit hops and big floral aromas strike your senses to produce a Supreme Champion beer of Britain.

CIDERS

Biddenden Vineyards – Biddenden, Ashford, Kent

- Medium 8.4% - A medium wine style cider made from farm pressed Kent grown culinary and dessert apples. **SOLD ONLY IN HALVES.**

Farmer Jims Cider – Newton Abbott, Devon

- Rootin Tootin 4.0% - A medium cider blended with spicy ginger and tart raspberry.

Lilley's Cider – Frome, Somerset

- Crazy Goat 6.8% - A medium- sweet mix of juicy still perry and cider expertly blended giving a mouth-watering juicy flavour.
- Gladiator 8.4% - This strong rustic cider with its Roman flair has everything well rounded, fruity, packed full of flavour and easy to drink for an 8.4% medium cider. **SOLD ONLY IN HALVES.**
- Mango Cider 4% - A smooth and sophisticated mango cider made with an ample portion of mango juice and Somerset Cider.
- Merry Monkey Scrumpy 4.5% - A medium scrumpy made with unfiltered bittersweet apple, full of character with a rich appley flavour.

Scrumpy Wasp Cider – East Markham, Newark, Nottinghamshire

- Apple & Rhubarb 4.0% - Red and crisp apples plus rhubarb shoots to give a sweet but tart drink for all to enjoy.

Snail's Bank Cider – Worcester

- Pig Ginger 4.0% - A clear and refreshing medium cider pepped up with freshly ground root ginger for a fiery kick.

Weston's Cider – Much Marcle, Herefordshire

- Rosie's Pig 4.8% - An easy drinking cloudy cider with a fresh apple flavour and hints of citrus and spice.
