
## Your Gift - The help it can give

Any gift, irrespective of size, makes a difference. Two recent bequests together funded a new volunteer hostel and other vital staff and volunteer facilities.

Examples of how a gift can be used include:

- ► £1,000 will buy a new set of period enamel signs
- ► £5,000 will buy a set of brass gauges and fittings for a locomotive
- £10,000 will buy a new set of carriage doors
- ► £25,000 will help fund vital facilities to conserve historic Island railway artefacts and archives
- ► £50,000 will renovate the original historic Havenstreet station building (our 'star' exhibit) or restore a 4-wheeled woodenbodied Victorian carriage to its former glory
- ▶ £100,000 will fund a new locomotive boiler
- ► £250,000 will provide a new essential building at Havenstreet
- ► £500,000 will help construct a replica Island locomotive
- ► £1 Million will provide a fully equipped engineering workshop to allow us to fully restore, maintain and preserve our locomotive fleet for future generations to enjoy



#### About us and what we do

The Isle of Wight Steam Railway is an Island gem. We are an educational charity, a leading tourist attraction and one of the largest Island-based Heritage organisations.

We have won many national awards for our work and are recognised as a national centre of excellence in the restoration of Victorian and Edwardian rail vehicles.

#### **Bringing history alive**

Our work is not just about restoration and display. We preserve by using our artefacts and we educate by allowing people to be part of the experience – seeing the working practices of a bygone age in action and experiencing the railway as it was meant to be; in effect stepping through a door into the past. Each year, thousands of people and hundreds of school groups make this journey with us and are inspired to appreciate and value inventions which transformed the world, the nation and this Island



#### How can a Legacy help?

Conservation and restoration of historical artefacts or records is an expensive process. The income from our day-to-day operations and extensive events programme can meet the costs of routine maintenance and smaller improvements.

However, major investments in new projects require finance from other sources. A legacy can fund a smaller project in its entirety, or it can help us access larger grants which often

require 'match' funding. A legacy can provide this match funding, enabling us to access a larger grant for a major restoration project. Thus the overall value of a legacy can be significantly enhanced ensuring an even greater and longer lasting memorial to the generosity of the benefactor."

We have a strategy for development over the next 20 to 30 years. Included are the provision of enhanced educational and interpretive facilities to greatly improve our visitors' experience, new maintenance and repair facilities plus a range of other improvements to ensure the Railway's long term future and increase public access to all aspects of the collection.
