



Alpha Male Craft Beer - Wolf Pack 4.2%

Arundel Brewery - Arundel, Sussex - Sussex Dark 5.5%

A rich, smooth ale brewed from Goldings and Magnum hops with a deep malty taste, subtle aromatic fruits and a bitter-sweet coffee finish.



Bradfield Brewery – High Bradfield, Sheffield Farmers Mild 3.4%

A well-rounded malty body and a moderate fruity hop finish.



Bristol Beer Factory – Ashton, Bristol – Espresso Martini Stout 4.5%

A classic, super-smooth milk stout shaken, not stirred, with dark, roasted coffee beans amplifying this brew into the stout stratosphere.



Bruha Brewing – Eye Suffolk – Meraki Stout 4.2%

A rich stout, smooth on the palate with notes of chocolate, oak and cedar.



Buxton Brewery – Buxton, Derbyshire – Mug Shot 5.2%

A rich, robust, easy drinking coffee infused porter with a good hint of chocolate.



Cerne Abbas Brewery – Cerne Abbas, Dorset – Mrs Vales Ale 5.6%

Caramel and dried fruit have a great presence with a warming, enduring finish in this complex old ale



Goddards Brewery – Branstone, Isle of Wight – Punched Porter 5.0% 5

A robust and silky-smooth porter with an intense depth of flavour and as close as you will get to a traditional porter



Harvey’s Brewery – Lewes, East Sussex – Old Ale 4.3%

A dark warming brew where burnt sugars and roasted malts compliment the premium Maris Otter barley with hints of dried fruit and dates.



Harvey’s Brewery – Lewes, East Sussex- Prince of Denmark 7.5%

A complex strong dark beer where brown, amber and black malts are mixed with pale ale malts to give aromas of leather, chocolate and liquorice. “ Alas, poor Yorick! I knew him, Horatio.”



Island Ales – Newport, Isle of Wight – Black & Wight I P A 5.0%

A black I P A with hoppy, fruity overtones – moreish.
A special brew for the festival

Island Ales – Shalfleet, Isle of Wight - Earl’s R D A 5.0%
A rich dark ale (RDA) brewed with **Crystal and Chocolate malts together** with roasted barley to give a glorious cappuccino aftertaste



Island Ales – Shalfleet, Isle of Wight - Oatmeal Stout 1875 4.5%
A beer with subtle aromas of fruit with coffee and chocolate flavours.
Brewed specially for the 200th Anniversary of Railways.



Island Ales – Shalfleet, Isle of Wight - Vectis Venom 4.8%
Easy drinking because of its deceptive character and darkness of colour, with an underlying smoothness to deliver its potion in the most satisfying of ways.



Kerrs Farm Brewed Ales – Pathmead, Edinburgh – Glasgow Porter 3.6%
A silky smooth and rich beer.



Luda Brewery – Louth, Lincolnshire – Black Mass 4.0%
A lower ABV stout delivering a decadent blend of chocolate indulgence, subtle roastiness and a hint of smokiness



Magpie Brewery – Nottingham – One for Sorrow 4.8%
A silky-smooth oatmeal stout with rich, roast, bonfire toffee, raisin and coffee flavours.



Milestone Brewery – Newark, Nottingham – Black Pearl 4.3%
A full-bodied, black, authentic stout made with American Nugget and Gallena hops



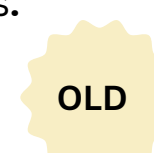
Nene Valley Brewery – Oundle, Northants – Egyptian Cream 4.5%
A velvety mouthfeel and full-bodied richness with a fruity hop bite from Magnum and Comet hops which balance this creamy milk stout.



Orkney Brewery – Orkney – Orca Oatmeal Stout 4.2%
A deep dark black stout with a creamy head, rich and full-flavoured with creamy chocolate, nuts and notes of toffee from the roasted barley and a bittersweet balance from the oats.



Palmers Brewery – Bridport, Dorset – Tally Ho! 5.5%
A complex old ale with roast malts and treacle toffee on the palate leading to a long lingering finish with more than a hint of coffee



Wight Knuckle Brewery – Brading, Isle of Wight – Dark Ale 4.3%
Boasting a rich, toasty maltiness, combined with a gentle sweetness and a creamy body which is the perfect way to fend off the cold, dreary winter months



Yates’ Brewery – Newchurch, Isle of Wight - Dark Side of the Wight –5.0%
A ruby dark beer with aromas of chocolate malt and biscuit and chocolate in the taste



Yates’ Brewery – Newchurch, Isle of Wight – - Yule Be Sorry 7.2%
A very dark coloured winter ale using pale and roasted malts, then 3 hops are added to make it a rich full-bodied beer.
