Abbeydale Brewery -Sheffield - Dr Morton’s Clown Poison 4.1% - GF

A light and refreshing fruity pale ale with Amarillo and Mosaic hops.



Beermats Brewing Co - Nottinghamshire Prismatic 4.5% -

A Refreshing beer with grapefruit, passionfruit, Pine and berry flavours Plus a hoppy, bitter finish.



Brass Castle Brewery -Malton - North Yorkshire Best 3.9% - GF/VG

A copper -hued real Yorkshire bitter that declares traditional quality with every mouthful.



Brunswick Brewery – Derby – Black Sabbath 6%

A multi award winning strong ale that is as strong as the name suggests. Dangerously quaffable, a smooth liquorice flavours.



Cerne Abbas Brewery – Dorset – Gurn Coconuts Rum Stout 6.7 %

A robust stout stout with a coconut sweetness and a rich body.



Copper Street Brewery – Dorchester, Dorset – Brego 6.5%

A premium English ale with traditional, uncompromising & bold flavours.



Fownd Brewery - Kidderminster – Seven Crowns 4.5%

A seasonal Indian pale ale where the trifecta of Cascade, comet and Amarillo hops create a super brew packed with berries, citrus and pine.



Full Circle Brewery – Newcastle upon Tyne – Stout 3.9% - GF

A roasted coffee and chocolate aroma of this silky smooth stout is followed swiftly with flavours of rich malt and a mild Goldings hop bitterness.

Goddard's Brewery – Isle of Wight - Fuggle Dee Dum 4.8%
A chestnut red premium ale brewed with English Fuggle hops and roasted malts to give a Smokey, spicy hoppiness on the nose.



Goff’s Brewery – Winchcombe - Joustier 4%
A tawny coloured ale, with a light hoppiness in the aroma, and a good balance of malt and bitterness in the mouth, underscored by fruitiness, with a clean hoppy aftertaste.



Goff’s Brewery – Winchcombe - Black Knight 5.3%
A very dark, ruby-red tinted beer with powerful chocolate malt aromas and a hint of vanilla.



Island Ales – Isle of Wight - Earl’s RDA 5%
A rich dark ale brewed with crystal and chocolate malts together with roasted barley to give a glorious cappuccino aftertaste.



Island Ales – Isle of Wight - Rocket Black 5%
A black IPA with hoppy, fruity overtones, very moreish. A special brew for 200 years of Britain's railways.



Island Ales – Isle of Wight - Tennyson 4.5%
A traditional IPA combining Simcoe and Cascade hops to produce an exciting full-flavoured pale ale.



Island Ales – Isle of Wight - Vectis Venom 4.8%
Easy drinking because of its deceptive character and darkness of colour, with an underlying smoothness to deliver its potion in the most satisfying of ways.



Island Ales – Isle of Wight - Wight Gold 4%
A golden bitter brewed with rounded Crystal malt and hops throughout.



Jacaranda Brewing Co. - Nottinghamshire – Kestrel’s Flight 4.4%- VG
Smooth and full-bodied, with roasted mail, chocolate and coffee.





Marble Brewery – Manchester– Manchester Bitter 4.2%
A fondly-remembered original. Speciality malt gives the deep golden colour and robust base, balanced by crisp bitterness and a floral, lemony aroma.



Moor Brewry - Bristol - Dark Mild 3.2%
a complex-layered dark mild that drinks very full and rich fir its sessional able ABV.



Munyards Brewery - Lincolnshire - My Father 4.2%
a traditional ale using Challenger and Golding hops to create a balance of bitterness and aroma to give a malty flavour.



Orkney Brewery - Orkney - Thor’s Hammer 5.1%
A forceful brew with Warrior and Dragon hops providing resinous, impactful lemon and tropical fruit.



Ossett Brewery - West Yorkshire - Silver King 4.3%
A simple combination of UK pale malt and American Cascade hopes resulting in a crisp, dry and refreshing pale ale.



Palmers Brewery - Dorest- 200 5%
A full bodied, rich and malty premium ale, originally brewed in 1994 to celebrate 200 years of brewing at Palmers.



Palmers Brewery - Dorset - Tally Ho! 5.5%
A complex old ale with roast malts and treacle toffee on the palate leading to a long lingering finish.



Round Corner Brewery- Lincolnshire - Market Bitter 3.4%
A session golden bitter where bready and Caramel malts underpin an elegant floral and fruity hop aroma.



Rudgate Brewery - North Yorkshire - Ruby Mild 4.4%
A nutty rich ruby ale, stronger than usual for a mild.

Titanic Brewery - Stroke on Trent - Plum Porter 4.9%
A well-rounded strong dark porter with fruit sweet notes from the plums over a backdrop of hoppy flavour.



Wickham House Brewery - Lincolnshire - Tanner & Hyde 4%
A full-bodied pale English style beer with a fruity caramel colour and a slid bitterness in taste.



Vocation Brewery - West Yorkshire- Pride & Joy 5.3%
A pale, crisp hoppy and aromatic beer where robust hop flavours are layered over a balanced malty backbone.



Vocation Brewery- West Yorkshire - Heart & Soul 4.4%
Expect a fruit salad flavour with bold notes of passionfruit, grapefruit, gooseberry, pineapple and mango.



Wight Knuckle Brewery- Isle of Wight - Best 4.2%
A delightful, full and classic tradtional, well -balanced ale crafted with 3 British hops.



Woodforde’s Brewery - Norfolk - Great Eastern 4.3%
A sensational pale ale using carefully crafted American and French hops to deliver a burst of fruity flavour.



Wylam Brewery - Newcastle upton tyne- Plain 4.7%
A plain and simple porter with a malt bill of Simpson’s finest Golden promise, Oat, Brown and Roast barley.



Yates’ Brewery - Isle of Wight - Beachcomber 4.3%
A straw-coloured easy drinking summer ale with a distinctive fresh aroma and a crisp, clean, hoppy finish.

An amber bitter with an earthy aroma and tastes of grapefruit, spice and pine.
