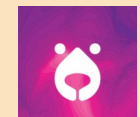


Abbeydale Brewery — Sheffield

Moonshine 4.3% GF/V PALE ALE
A well balanced multi award winning pale ale with a delicate floral aroma and a bitter finish.

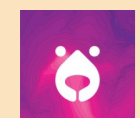


Daily Bread 3.8% GF/V BITTER
Well balanced mix of malt and hops, this light brown bitter has a gentle caramel and fruity background, finishing dry & bitter.



Beartown Brewery — Cheshire

Kahuna 4.5% SPECIALITY
Passion fruit aromas dominate this well balanced very fruity beer. Some pleasant hops compliment the sweetness and last well in the finish.



Crème Bearlee 4.8% PORTER
Chocolate and vanilla aromas with malty, caramel and roasty flavours which combine with a sweet body to be followed by a drier finish.



Bond Brews—Wokingham, Berkshire

Railway Porter 4.5% PORTER
A brown coloured porter with roast, malt and fruit aromas. In the taste, bitterness and hops come through to dominate, but in the aftertaste, slight peppery and earthy flavours appear that give way to a sharp chocolate finish.

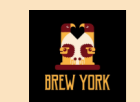


Lite Sabre Golden Mild 3.6% MILD
A beer in a very rare style that is hardly ever seen, a Golden Mild. Lightly hopped it has a low bitterness level and a hint of honey and spice.



Brass Castle Brewery—Yorkshire

Quench 3.8% GF/V PALE ALE
Hazy New England style hoppy pale with Citra and Mosaic Hops.



Brew York—Yorkshire

Calmer Chameleon 4.1% PALE ALE
The green dream of hyper juicy and resinous hops Columbus, Mosaic, Simcoe and Idaho uniting in a super smashable pale ale.



Monkey Brewhouse—Lymington.

Knightwood 4.4% GOLDEN
Golden ale with a gentle honeyed malts and hop notes of apricot, nectarine and citrus fruits.



Lymington Special 4.8% BITTER
A mid-brown premium bitter. Well balanced with malt, hop and tangerine sitting over a light caramel taste. Hop bitterness soon disappears leading to a slightly dry finish, with a light peachy sweetness.



Charnwood Brewery—Leicestershire

By George 4.6% BITTER
A traditional English ruby-coloured premium bitter. A combination of pale, crystal malts give an upfront sweetness tempered by the late addition of spicy hops.



Flower Pots Brewery—Hampshire

Busters Best 4.2% BITTER
A beautiful dark brown beer. Smooth and medium bodied. Nutty biscuit and sweet caramel throughout with the essential delicate hop backbone and bitterness that strengthens in the aftertaste together with the sweetness.



Pots Bitter 3.8% BITTER
A refreshing, easy going, traditional bitter. An initial sweetness with dry, earthy hop flavours is balanced by a robust maltiness. Bitter throughout with a hoppy aroma and dry bitter finish.



Goddards Brewery—Sandown Isle of Wight

GSB 4.0% BITTER
Refreshingly, clean, easy-drinking bitter, with a wonderful aroma of freshly rubbed hops that carries through to a satisfying aftertaste.



South Island Pale Ale 4.2% PALE ALE
A low bitterness and light, easy drinking, full bodied pale ale with passion fruit, gooseberry and grapefruit aromas that has been made with a selection of hops from New Zealand, Australia, & America.



Fuggle Dee Dum 4.8% DARK BITTER
Chestnut-coloured strong ale with a deep hoppy taste, walnut bitterness with a rounded malty counter. Hints of caramel and roast add depth as a piquant blackcurrant sweetness filters through.



Island Brewery—Shalfleet Isle of Wight

Wight Gold 4.0% BITTER
A golden brown bitter brewed with rounded Crystal malt & hops throughout.



Earls RDA 5.0% STOUT
Rich yet understated stout, with classic espresso aftertaste.



Yachtsman 4.2% BITTER
Chestnut-coloured ale with a rich, malty mouthfeel and hop aroma.



Vectis Venom 4.8% BITTER
Malty, dark ruby red ale with and easy drinking and underlying smooth characteristic.

Little Brewing—Derby

Panther Oatmeal Stout 4.2% GF/V STOUT
A rich smooth warming stout with hints of coffee, chocolate and Irish whiskey, a very drinkable dark beer.



Loch Lomond Brewery—Dumbarton

Silky Stout 5.0% STOUT
Award winning black stout with chocolate–orange spicy notes.



Palmer's Brewery—Bridport Dorset

Tally Ho! 5.5% OLD ALE
A complex dark old ale with roast malts & treacle toffee on the palate, leading to a long lingering finish, with more than a hint of coffee. DING DONG!



Copper Ale 3.7% BITTER
Beautifully balanced copper-coloured light bitter with a hoppy aroma.



Redwillow Brewery—Macclesfield Cheshire

Headless 3.9% PALE
Balanced with some malty sweetness, fruit and hops show in the aroma and taste with hop bitterness lasting to the end.



Salopian Brewery—Shrewsbury

Lemon Dream 4.5% PALE ALE
A light gold ale brewed with wheat malt and subtly flavoured with fresh lemons.



St Peter's Brewery—Suffolk

Plum Porter 4.6% PORTER
A dark, sweet and full bodied plum porter. Background notes of damson and blackcurrant are followed by the fruitiness of the plum in flavour and aroma.



Titanic Brewery—Stoke on Trent

Raspberry Pale 4.7% SPECIALITY
This wonderfully fruity wheat beer is refreshingly light. The raspberry flavours bounce off the hops perfectly to result in a unique balanced beer.



Whiteknuckle Brewery—Nunwell

Pale 4.0% PALE ALE
Pale bursting with citrus flavours skilfully contained within a light crisp ale. Maris Otter, Caramalts Munich and Lager Hops.



Best 4.2% BITTER
A classic traditional bitter, a flavour profile that has stood the test of time, soft body with notes of caramel and spice.



Yates' Brewery—Newchurch

Beachcomber 4.5% PALE ALE
Straw coloured easy drinking summer ale with a distinctive fresh aroma and a clean, hoppy finish.



Holy Joe 4.9% BITTER
An amber-coloured ale with a bittersweet aftertaste..

Known as a popular, classic ale from Ventnor Brewery. Originally brewed by Burts Brewery.
